

Overarching goal of the NZC

Aim to be an internationally acknowledged climate research and training centre with emphasis on tropical and high-latitude regions, and the interactions between these regions, for past, present and future climate.

Research activities

1. Construction of past climate and climate variability based on proxy data, and by use of modelling.

2. Development and evaluation of seasonal-to-decadal time scale climate predictability systems, and identification of low-and-high latitude teleconnection patterns and mechanisms. 3.Model and assess long-term climate effects of regional to global scale atmospheric events

4.Assess sources and sinks of carbon dioxide on seasonal to interdecadal time scales based on observations and modelling.




